

THE COMPOSER

William Himes (b. 1949) earned his Bachelor and Master of Music degrees from the University of Michigan. For five years he taught instrumental music in the public schools of Flint, Michigan, where he was also adjunct lecturer in low brass at the University of Michigan-Flint. Mr. Himes continues to be in demand as conductor, composer, lecturer, clinician, and euphonium soloist and has appeared throughout the United States, Australia, New Zealand, Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Jamaica, Argentina, Japan, and the United Kingdom.

Since 1977, Mr. Himes has been music director of The Salvation Army's Central Territory, which encompasses the eleven midwestern states. In this capacity he is also conductor of the Chicago Staff Band, an internationally recognized ensemble which he has led on successful tours of New Zealand, Chile, Canada, Jamaica, Mexico, Singapore, the Philippines, Hong Kong, England, South Korea, and Australia.

THE COMPOSITION

Episode and Chorale is the result of several factors and influences. It was written in honor of my dear friend, Joseph Dobos, a dedicated and gifted music educator. For thirty-four years Joseph taught instrumental music in the Lapeer Community School District, Lapeer, Michigan—his first and only job out of college!

In addition to his work as a teacher, Joe has been a life long church organist. With this immersion in hymnody it was not surprising to learn that his favorite melody was the ancient Irish hymn tune, "St. Columba." Therefore, I based **Episode and Chorale** on the melodic structure of "St. Columba," although it never appears in its original (and majestic) 3/4 meter. Instead, I transformed it into a cheery "walking tune" as it first appears in bars 5-13, befitting the positive personality of my friend.

I also wanted to feature a texture that would reflect the influence of the pipe organ, hence the contrasting chorale beginning at bar 49. The theme is simplicity itself, calling for sonority and expression. The relationship to the principal tune may not be immediately evident but the connection will be obvious as the piece unfolds.

The return to the initial Allegro vivo at bar 67 provides opportunity to exploit the chorale in minor mode leading into the finale beginning at bar 87. The development continues with the walking tune and chorale converging at bar 95—a contrapuntal device often found in organ repertoire. With so many textures present, the key to achieving clarity will be to observe the contrasting styles for each function (i.e., the walking tune should be bouncy, the chorale sustained and the trumpet fanfare accented). Overall the mood should be bright and joyful – a celebration in sound!
